❑ Chemical use screenings

- Free!
- A brief face-to-face interview and a discussion of recommendations
- Assistance in accessing community resources including a full chemical use assessment

❑ Comprehensive chemical use assessments

- \$205 fee; full assessment summary for the referrer, and a letter with recommendations for the patient will be issued upon completion of the assessment

❑ Outpatient chemical dependency treatment for adults and adolescents

RECOVERY SUPPORT SERVICES

We recognize that treatment is only the beginning of the healing process. We work hard on helping patient's to create continuing care plans that reflect their discharge needs and we are here to provide support even after the program is completed.

- Recovery Support Group: A trained volunteer facilitates a free group every Wednesday 10 to 11 a.m. and 5:30 to 6:30 p.m.
- The Recovery Specialist, a trained Recovery Coach, supports each group by meeting with each facilitator monthly to discuss the motivation of group members, group dynamics and resources available to individuals in recovery

- Sober activities organized by our [LIFE Club alumni group](#) and designed to put the fun in recovery
