☐ Chemical use screenings

- o Free
- o Assistance in accessing community resources

☐ Chemical Awareness and Substance Abuse Education

- o *Chemical Awareness* is a 4-hour education workshop designed for individuals beginning to experience early consequences of drug and alcohol use. There is a \$50 fee for this workshop.
- o Substance Abuse Education is a 12-hour program. There is a \$200 fee for this program.

□ Comprehensive chemical use assessments

\$205 fee; full assessment summary for the referrer, and a letter with recommendations for the patient will be issued upon completion of the assessment

□ Outpatient chemical dependency treatment for adults

- o Comprehensive chemical use assessments completed to determine program needs
- o Primary Group sessions held on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday from 9a.m. to 12p.m. or 5 to 8 p.m. for approximately eight weeks
- o Transitions Group held on Wednesdays from 9a.m. to 11a.m. or 5 to 7 p.m. for approximately eight to 12 weeks
- Individualized treatment plans
- Individual and group counseling
- Family involvement
- Alcohol and drug education
- o The 12 Steps of Alcoholics Anonymous and Narcotics Anonymous are integrated into the program
- o Counseling staff utilizes Cognitive-Behavioral and Motivational Enhancement interventions throughout the patient's course of treatment
- o Addiction Psychiatrist serves as the Medical Director and provides staff consultation

RECOVERY SUPPORT SERVICES

We recognize that treatment is only the beginning of the healing process. We work hard on helping the patient to create continuing care plans that reflect their discharge needs and we are here to provide support even after the program is completed.

- o Recovery Support Group: A volunteer facilitates a free group every Wednesday evening 5 to 6 p.m.
- The Recovery Specialist, a trained Recovery Coach, supports each group by meeting with each facilitator monthly to discuss the motivation of group members, group dynamics and resources available to individuals in recovery
- Sober activities organized by our LIFE Club alumni group and designed to put the fun in recovery
