A clinic that treats minor medical conditions

- Alleraies

- Cold sores
- Head lice
- Immunizations
- Insect and tick bites
- Strep throat

Urgent Care

6 months + (Eau Claire) Newborn (Other sites) Offers same-day minor medical treatment

- Back or muscle pain
- Cuts and minor burns
- Ear ache
- Skin conditions
- Sprains or joint pain
- Upper respiratory infection and bronchitis
- · Urinary tract infections
- Vomiting and diarrhea









Express Care Online

18 months – 75 years Offers same-day or next-day medical advice and/or treatment

- Life- or limb-threatening injury
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Signs of stroke, including sudden numbness, slurred speech, severe headache, weakness on one side of the face or loss of consciousness
- Signs of a heart attack, including chest pain, pain in the left arm or iaw, sudden weakness or dizziness

Emergency Department

Delivers care for severe and life-threating situations that require immediate medical attention

- Chest pain or pressure
- Head injuries
- Seizures
- Severe abdominal pain
- Shortness of breath or pneumonia
- Sudden, severe headaches, paralysis or weakness
- Uncontrolled bleeding
